
The Company offers Two - year warranty for this product for repairing or replacing parts, free of cost against defects in manufacturing functional subject to the following terms and conditions.



### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION





### ) HOT & COLD WATER INLET

Connect here with the inlet hose from the water faucet to feed water to the tub Wash Tub (Left) / Spin tub (Right)

### i) FEEDING WATER LABLE

When the water spills out of the hole under the lable, it means too much water has supplied. Close the water tap and adjust the level.

SPIN TIMER
Select the desired time for spinning. The maximum limit is 5 min., but shall not be continued over 3 cycle.Don't rotate the knob more than prescribed limit

## vii) BUZZER:

End of Wash/Rinse cycle is indicated by cycle end buzzer.

**DRAIN SELECTOR**Select "Wash • Rinse" for washing and rinsing and "Drain" to drain the water

# out of the tub. WASH SELECTOR

Set the program to "Normal", "Strong" according to kinds and quantity of the laundry.

### WASH TIMER

Select the desired time for washing or rinsing. The maximum is 15 min.

## **PRODUCT INSTALLATION**

## Installation area

- Set on flat and firm floor.
- Incorrect installation may course severe noise and break down.



- Maintain more than 10 cm. between the side of drain hose and the wall.
- A carpet must not obstruct the ventilation openings.



# Connecting the earth wire

- Install the earth wire to prevent short-circuit due to leaking current and electric shock.
- It is attached at the back of the washer. Connect it to the metal water pipe. If the water pipe is made of plastic it does not have the earth effect.
- Do not connect the earth wire to the gas pipe, lightning arrester, telephone connecter, etc



**X** Warning-the appliance with two-pronged plug must be grounded.

# Connecting the power plug


- Insert the power plug into the outlet.
- Before connecting the power plug, check if the voltage setting of the washer matches the outlet voltage.
- If AC outlet with ground terminal is used, grounding is not needed. If not, never forget earthing (earthing method above).
- The appliance must be positioned so that the plug is accessible.

# Voltage Change (only for dual voltage)

This washer is assembled for 230V, but can be changed from 230V to 110V

Check your electrical source and follow the diagram below to convert voltage.

 Connect to the When installing it in an earthing-only outlet. area where earthing is not possible, purchase a short-circuit breaker connect it to the outlet.





## **How to Wash**

### Before washing

- Check the washing instruction labels on the clothing to be washed
- Remove all objects from the pockets of the clothing. Objects left in the pockets may damage clothing or break the washing machine (could cause the drain hose to clog). Wash After seperating oiled and dyed clothing.
- For your convenience hang up the wash cover on the right or left side of the washing machine tub when not in use.



- Set the knob to "WASH / RINSE"
- 2. Fill the tub with water according to the weight of cloth (Refer table 1 and 2).
- 3. Put the clothes in the tub. Do not put an excessive amount of laundry, in the tub. (Refer table 1 and 2).
  4. Put recommendable quantity of detergent as mentioned in Table 1.
  5. Set the Wash Selector to NORMAL & STRONG mode as you desired

- 6. Set Wash Time up to 15min, depending on your cloth load & type (Refer Table 2).
- 7. When washing is completed, drain off the washing water by adjusting the knob to "DRAIN" position. 8. After the washing water is discharged, turn the knob switch to "WASH / RINSE" position. 9. Fill the water up to the desired level for rinsing.

Note: Water level may be less than the water level line while washing. If so, refill the water. Be careful not to exceed the indicated water level line; it may cause water to spill out of the tub

## How to Spin/Rinse

## Interim spin rinse

- Interim spin rinse prior to regular rinsing helps removing sudsy water from the laundry and improve rinsing efficiency. Also is helpful to water saving
  - After washing. 2 Connect inlet hose to water supply inlet in Spin tub Move the laundry into the spin dryer basket. Place the safety cove
    - 3 Set the desired spin flow


  If the spinning fail to stop when the spin dryer cover is opened, the brake is out of order. Immediately stop using the machine and request repair service.

## Cleaning the Lint Filter

- 1. Pull out the lint filter from the lock use fingers pull out at the part of the Lint Filters side.
- Turn the net inside out and clean with water.
- 3. Set back to the original position. Insert the bottom first as shown press down and lock as the arrow.


